**4. VENUE AND DATE OF REGATTA**

Caldé – Lake Maggiore, August 24-27, 2010. In the water in front of the club  
First Race Tuesday, August 24; Warning Signal at 1.00 p.m.

Up to ten (10) races may be held. Every day not more than 3 races will be sailed.

On Friday, August 27 no warning signal will be displayed after 4 p.m.

**5. RACING RULES OF SAILING**

The Regatta will be governed by:

- Rules as defined by the Racing Rules of Sailing;
- Regulations of the Italian Sailing Authority F.I.V. for agonistic activity for 2010;
- In presence of qualified Race Officials with application of the Appendix “P” (Special Procedures for Rule 42)

In case of conflict due to different languages, the Italian version of this Notice of Race prevails.

**6. SCHEDULE OF THE REGATTA**

Thursday, August 26: Races  
Friday, August 27: Races, Prize-Giving Ceremony.

**7. ADMISSION**

The regatta is open to all boats of Laser BUG Class.

The use of the 5.3 sq.m. BUG sail is obligatory for helmsmen born in 1995,1996, 1997.

The use of the 5.3 sq.m. BUG sail is discrezionario for helmsmen born in 1998 (12 years old).

The use of the 5.3 sq.m. BUG sail is consented for helmsmen born in 1999, 2000, as long as the crew is of two persons.

The use of the 3.8 sq.m. BUG sail is obligatory for helmsmen born in 1998 (not yet 12 year old to the date of the regatta) 1999, 2000.

The use of 3.8 sq.m. Bug sail is discrezionario for helmsmen born in 1998 (12 year olds to the data of regatta)

**8. ELIGIBILITY**

Competitors shall have valid sailing license issued by their National Authority; they shall have settled the Class fee and each boat shall be insured with valid third party liability insurance with a minimum cover of Euro 1,000,000.00 or the equivalent.

All documents will be delivered to the Organising Committee upon registration.

**9. ADVERTISING**

Advertising is permitted according to Class Rules.

The organizing authority may ask competitors to display sponsor flags and/or stickers on the boats. Flags and/or stickers shall be displayed since the start of the first race until the end of the regatta.

**10. ENTRIES**

The entries, addressed to the CNC Secretariat, shall be submitted within August .14<sup>th</sup> 2010 by mail, fax, e-mail. The entry fee of Euro 50,00 shall be paid upon registration

The entry of a competitor under the age of eighteen has to be signed by their parent or legal guardian and, in their absence, accompanied by a document stating the validity of the signature.

**11. MEASUREMENT, BOAT AND EQUIPMENT**

No previous measurement controls will be performed, but boat or equipment inspections may be performed any time for compliance upon decision of the Race Committee or Protest Committee.

All Competitors will use only one hull, sail, mast, boom, centreboard, rudder that may be identified during measurement inspections.

The sail numbers shall comply with the Measurement Rules.

No change of rigging is allowed without permission of the Race Committee.

**12. SCORING**

The Low Point System of Appendix A will be used.

When five (5) races have been completed, one score can be excluded and 2 scores can be excluded after the 9<sup>th</sup> race. Three (3) races must be completed to constitute a series.

**13. PRIZES**

One prize for the first in each category, and souvenirs for each competitor. The Organizing Committee may assign additional prizes and/or draw prizes among the competitors.

**14. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS**

The Sailing Instructions shall be available at Office of the Regatta Secretary, at the site of C.N.C. , as of 9.00 a.m. of Tuesday August 24, 2010.

**15. COACHES AND TEAM LEADERS**

Coaches and Team Leaders shall register themselves and fill out the registration form available at Office of the Regatta Secretary; they shall declare the features of their support boat and accept the “rules for coaches and support boats” as described in the sailing instructions; furthermore, they shall declare the names of the competitors they assist. Registered Coaches and Team Leaders shall be submitted to the technical and disciplinary actions of the Race Committee and Protest Committee, who can withdraw the permission of staying inside the race area.

**16. DISCLAIMER OF LIABILITY**

According to the Fundamental Rule 4, competitors participate in the regatta of the present notice entirely at their own risk. The organizing authority will not accept any liability for material damage or personal injury or death sustained in conjunction with or prior to, during, or after the regatta, both on the water and on land.
